

## Camper Electronic Policy

Spending time at Camp Twin Creeks allows your child to take a break from many popular distractions that fill the home; PC's, DVD's, Facebook, IM and much more! Instead, they spend their time outdoors, socializing and appreciating a different form of entertainment.

With this in mind we provide a policy regarding electronics which outlines what campers may bring and how they should be used:

- \* Cell phones do not work at Camp. Any cell phones brought by campers will be looked after in the office and returned at the end of a session.
- \* PSP's and Nintendo DS' should not be brought to Camp.
- \* iPods and MP3's may be brought to Camp. Video content must be removed prior to arriving at Camp.
- \* Any PSP / DS / iPod with video brought for the bus journey will be looked after in the office and returned at the end of Camp.

As well as the social issue, these pieces of equipment are expensive and each summer campers lose games and damage the units. This can serve as a distraction for campers and can disrupt their time at Camp.
